PROGRAM HIGHLIGHT



Ultimate Year 5 & 6 Cookie Bake Off

At OOSH, our Year 5 and 6 students recently took part in a fun and engaging Chocolate Chip Cookie Challenge, guided by the My Time, Our Place framework. Working in small groups, the children came together to plan, cooperate and take shared responsibility for their task. They carefully read through recipes, identified the ingredients they required, and organised their workspace as a team, building their independence and strengthening their sense of identity and belonging (Outcome 1).

As they measured, mixed and prepared their cookie dough, the children demonstrated persistence, coordination and a growing awareness of safety and hygiene in the kitchen, supporting their overall wellbeing (Outcome 3). The group environment encouraged turn-taking, patience and positive communication, as everyone played a role in bringing their team's recipe to life. Through these shared experiences, they developed stronger connections with one another and practised contributing positively to a group setting (Outcome 2).

Once the cookies were baked, the children gathered together to enjoy the results of their hard work. This moment of reflection and celebration highlighted their growing confidence as capable and involved learners (Outcome 4), as well as the joy that comes from collaborating towards a common goal. The activity was not only a delicious success but also a meaningful opportunity for the children to practise life skills, teamwork and creativity in a supportive environment.



RECIPE OF THE TERM



Chocolate Chip Cookie

This term we ramped up the heat in the kitchen with some friendly competition amongst our year 5 and 6's. The children battled it out to make the best choc chip cookie. This was the winning recipe! (Thanks to Recipe Tin Eats)

Ingredients

- 225g unsalted butter
- 1 ½ cups dark chocolate chips
- ¾ cup milk chocolate chips

Dry Ingredients


- 2 cups plain flour
- 3 Teaspoons cornflour
- ¼ Teaspoon baking powder
- ½ Teaspoon baking soda
- ½ Teaspoon cooking salt

Wet Ingredients

- 1 cup brown sugar, tightly packed
- ½ cup caster sugar
- 1 large egg
- 1 egg yolk
- 1 Teaspoon vanilla extract

Method

1. Brown butter and allow to cool.
2. Whisk dry ingredients together in a separate bowl.
3. Add sugars to browned butter and hand mix in, then egg, yolk and vanilla.
4. Whisk dry ingredients into wet ingredients. Once almost mixed in, add chocolate chips.
5. Form ½ cup sized disks, cover and refrigerate for 12-24 hours.
6. Preheat oven to 170 degrees celcius (fan forced).
7. Bake for approximately 17 minutes.
8. Allow to cool and enjoy!
