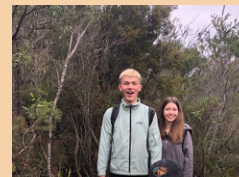
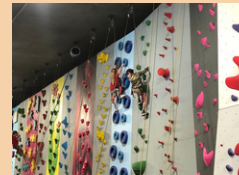
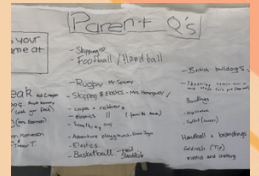
Notes
